President Doreen Roadcap called the May meeting of the Shenandoah Valley Quilters Guild (SVQG) to order at 9:30 a.m. There was 1 visitor, Susie Farmer, director of the VQM.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the April minutes, as published in the newsletter, be approved.

Reports:

Service - Denise Rudolph – There are kits to make pillows available and quilts to bind. These will be distributed to Hospice following the quilt show.

Sunshine – There were 4 birthday cards and 1 thinking of you card mailed out.

Treasurer – Bev London presented her report.

Programs - Lori Abbott-Herrick. Mickey DePre was introduced.

Virginia Quilt Museum - Josephine Millet. The new exhibit will open on May 22nd. There will be a walk-around for volunteers to view the new exhibit from 11am – 1:30pm on the opening day. There is also a "Fly Me to the Moon" traveling exhibit that will be on display. On the 1st Friday of each month there will be children's activities.

Border Challenge – 6 finished quilts were presented for the members to vote for their favorite during the break. The members that created the 3 borders on the winning quilt will each receive a gift certificate.

Quilt Show – Sandie Hammel – There currently are 105 quilts submitted for the show with a final tally estimated to be 130 quilts. There is a need for 3 food trucks during the quilt show with one selling sweets and the others selling sandwiches. Help is need with publicity. There are posters and brochures available for the members to distribute. Cindy Holland passed around the volunteer list for everyone to review and confirm the time slots that they committed to help.

Ways and Means - Kathy Christy. There are 3 raffles ongoing. One is the guild raffle quilt. One is the monthly raffle and the third is a raffle for the sewing machine donated by Ragtime.

2019 Programs – Cindy Holland – More program ideas are needed from members. Some would like to see more programs geared towards beginners. Pat Sloan has been booked for the June 2019 meeting which will be on the 4th Saturday of June.
