Sausage Pinwheels – from Shelba Bellamy

2 pkg. Crescent Roll Sheets

1 lb. Sausage (Shelba used hot)

8 oz. Cream cheese, softened

Brown, crumble and drain the sausage. Mix the sausage and cream cheese together. Lay out the pastry sheet. Spread the sausage/cheese mixture onto the pastry sheet. Roll up the pastry sheet lengthwise – like a jellyroll. Slice into 1 inch pieces. Bake at 400° for 15-18 min. Yields 24-28 pinwheels.


Afternoon Workshop: Northern Lights Bargello

Each participant will need to purchase their own pattern prior to the class. They are available on-line at Annie's Craft Store for \$9.99. You can purchase a hard copy or download it at:



Northern Lights Bargello - Supply List

Confident Beginner/Intermediate Skill Level



Piecing this small bargello is easier than it appears. We will learn tricks to make the seams line up perfectly. There will be two options. The first is to make the original pattern. The second option is to add additional sections to make a longer version. If you choose to do the longer version like mine, please contact me for the additional yardage needed.

<Original Pattern

Northern Lights Supply List

- Fabrics as listed on the pattern.
- Sewing machine
- Walking foot (optional)
- Thread
- Glue stick
- Fork pins (optional but can be of great help) JoAnn's carries them.
- Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors etc)
- Cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter (slicing fabric strips)
- Iron and iron surface/ironing board
- **If you want to make the extended version like mine, please contact me and I will send the additional fabric yardage to you**

Northern Lights Homework

- Purchase and print pattern https://www.anniescatalog.com/detail.html?prod id=141869&cat id=1667
- Cut feature fabrics and background fabrics according to pattern instructions. We will be working on the main body of the quilt during the workshop. If there is time, we can start on the borders.
- Sew the five feature fabrics together and sew background rectangle to strip set.

Do not press seams or sew into a tube.	I will be showing you a
technique that will result in better piecing.

"Galaxy" - 6 hour Workshop - Friday - August 16, 2019

Galaxy is a beautiful alternating block design. Because of the color placement and the different angles in the triangles, interesting interlocking circles appear. It's a fun optical illusion, easy to make and even easier to admire. Required tool: V Block and Tucker Trimmer 1. Highly recommended tool: Quilter's Magic Wand

Three project sizes: 42" x 54", 63" x 81", or 84" x 108"
