May 18, 2019

President Debbie Jungling called the May meeting of the Shenandoah Valley Quilters Guild (SVQG) to order.

There was 1 visitor present from Augusta Health.

A correction was noted to the April minutes. Three members have volunteered to serve as the Hospitality Committee. They are Linda Quintrell, Deborah Smiley and Shelba Bellamy. It was moved, seconded and carried that the amended April minutes be approved.

Reports:

Ways and Means – Sue Jones – The quilt raffle drawing will be held at the end of the meeting. The raffle was won by Debbie Jungling.

Treasurer – Nina Jackson was not present and will have the Treasurer’s Report available by the end of the week.

Virginia Quilt Museum – Josephine Millett – All of the quilts submitted for the Quilt Show have been accepted for display. The artist statements of inspiration are due to Josephine by June 22<sup>nd</sup>. The quilts must have a hanging sleeve and label and be ready to hang on July 17<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are needed to help hang the quilts. The show will open on July 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Programs – Cindy Holland – Pat Sloan’s workshop will be held on Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup>. There are 5 open slots. Pat will give a lecture and trunk show at the meeting on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Lori Shrock is leading a workshop on July 20<sup>th</sup> called Bargello Northern Lights.

Programs 2 – A volunteer is needed to fill this open position.

Works-in-Progress – Cerise Haas – Project #4 will be due by the July meeting.

Old Business:

The Rockbridge Quilters Guild is holding a “Slash Your Stash” auction on June 8<sup>th</sup>. They are offering a \$50 prize for the best decorated basket of auction items donated for the auction.

New Business:

Sew Classics is now a Janome Machine Dealer. They are located at the Shenandoah Farmers Market.

It was voted and approved to have members make a 20” finished block (20 ½” unfinished) of their own design with an area for signatures. **Amazing!!!** This group is so supportive of the Service program. We had a great turnout at the meeting Saturday. 184 quilts, 11 patriotic pillow cases and 9 breast cancer pillow/totes!!!! This brings the total for the Service year (8/18 – 7/19) to 319!!!! I went back thru the records and we started giving to Hospice back in 2012. To this date we have given 1,644 quilts to Hospice and 39 quilts to children's groups such as Project Linus, Foster Kids Camp, and Healthy Starts.

So often when you hear people talk about quilters they say how giving they are and our group certainly proves this.

We had a good turnout at the afternoon session and got a lot of pillowcases cut out. Thank you to Sue Jones and Carolyn Purdy who delivered quilts – what a task that was!! I delivered the quilts to Blue Ridge. She showed me the cabinet they keep the quilts in and I thought – You are going to need a bigger cabinet!!!

The Quilts will be hung on Wednesday, July 17th, beginning at 10:00 am until we are finished. The exhibit opens on July 23rd and will run thru December 15, 2019.

If you cannot get your quilt to the Museum on July 17th, or have someone else deliver it for you, you can bring it to me at the meeting on June 22, 2019.

I am looking for a few volunteers to help in hanging the quilts, so let me know if you can help.

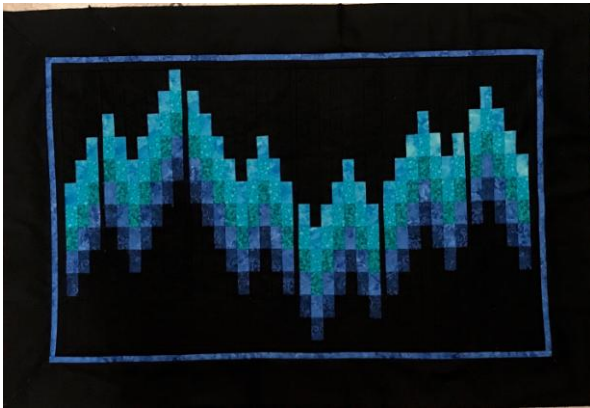
#### **Program and Workshop presented by Lori Schrock**
